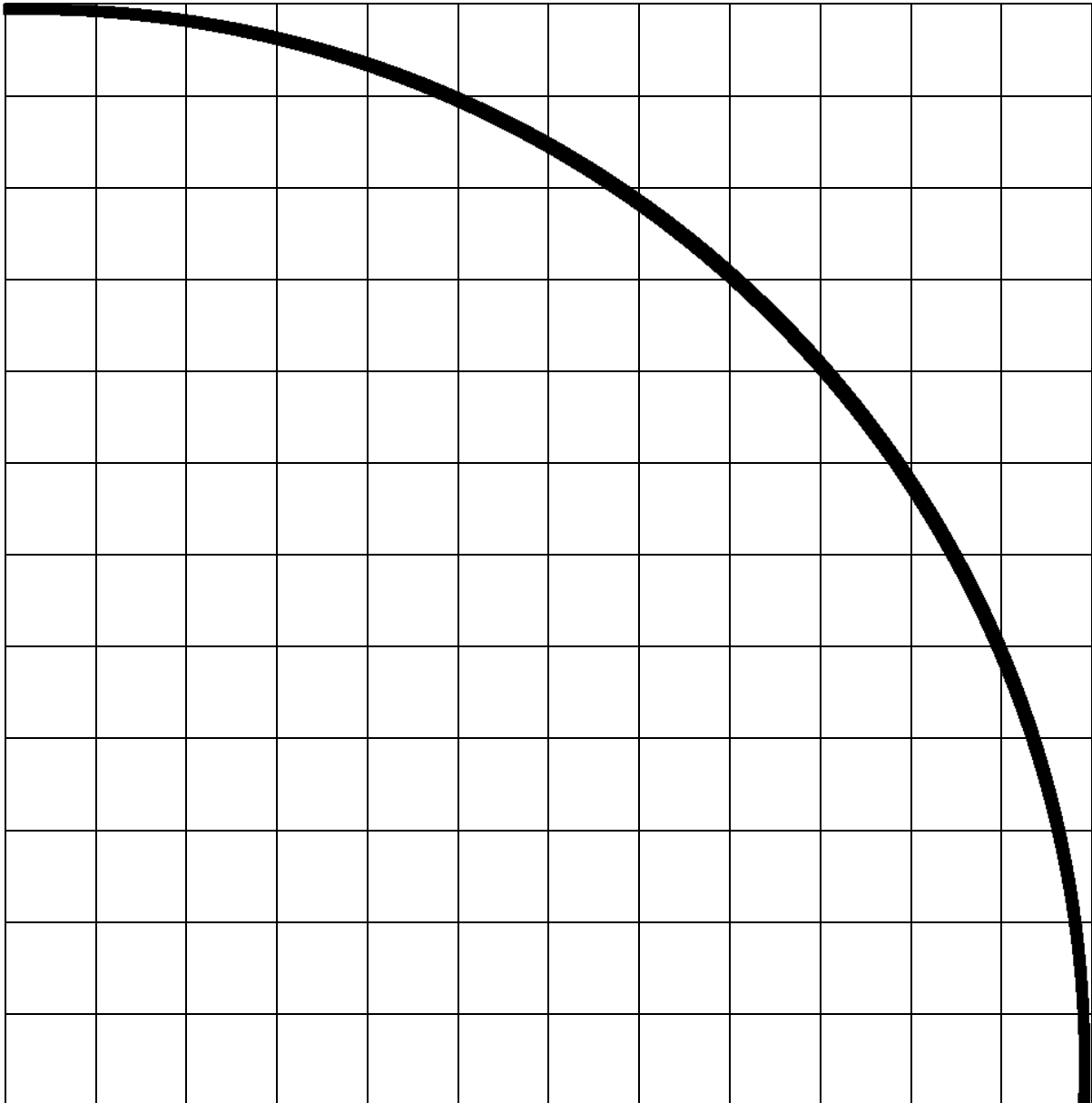


Calculate Pi with Chocolate – Part 2



Place chocolate chips on all the squares which lie completely inside the circle.

Place white chocolate chips on the rest of the squares.

Count all the chips inside the circle, multiply it by 4 and divide by the total number of squares (144).

Answer: $4 * 98/144 = 2.72$
Off by about 0.4 from 3.14, getting closer!
Could be improved by adding even more chocolate!
