



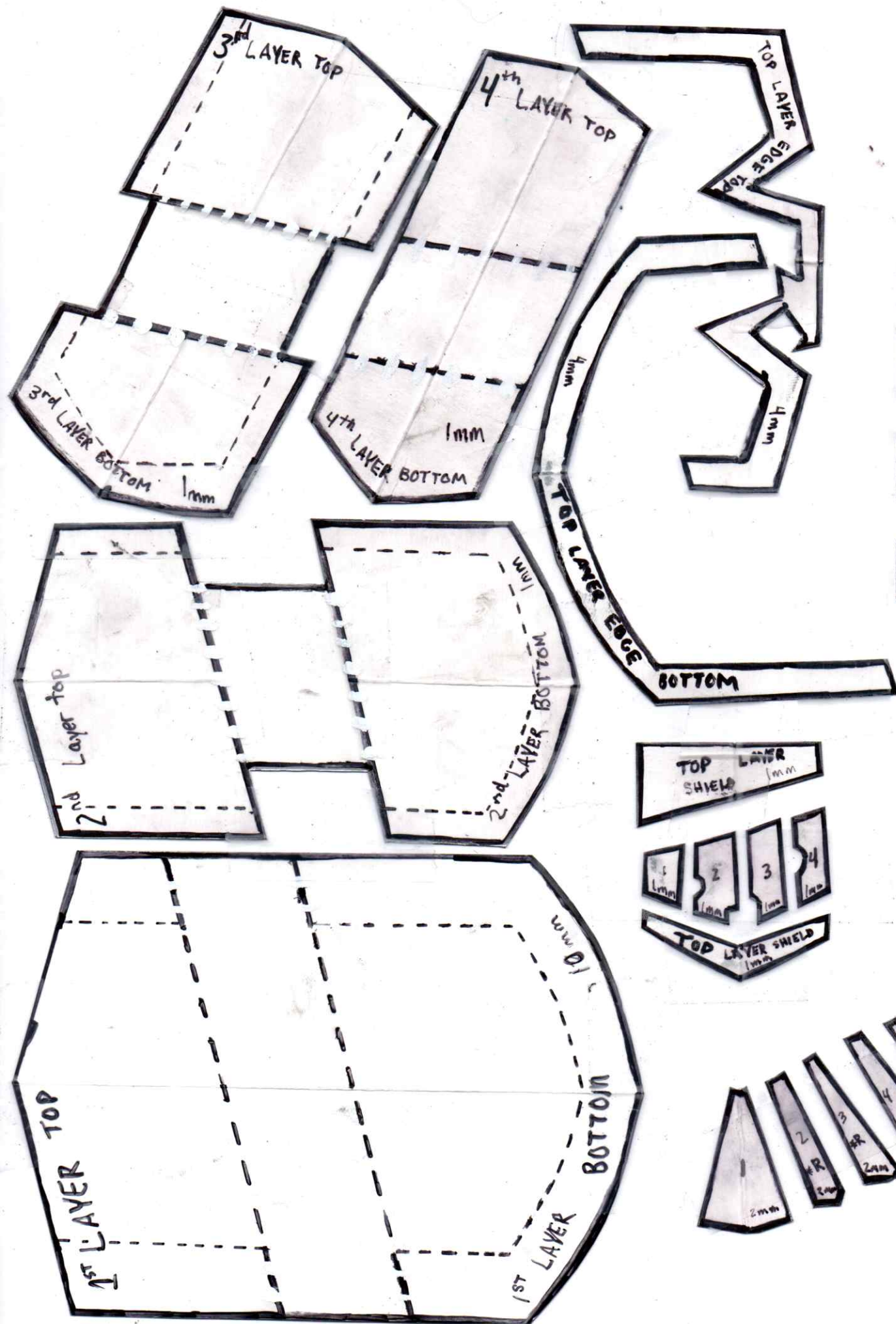
Judge Dredd Badge

I made this template for making a Judge Dredd badge from the 1995 movie Judge Dredd. Please feel free to make any modifications you would like.

- **Cut out all the pieces of the template and trace them onto the material of your choice (I used 10 mm, 4 mm, 2 mm & 1 mm EVA foam)**
- **All of the pieces have the size foam I used marked on them.**
- **Some parts are numbered to help you during assembly to know when to apply them. The badge "layers" are assembled first then all the small parts are added on top.**
- **There are dotted lines on this template for the layer parts. These lines are just to show you alignment for the next layer that glues onto it. You can trace them onto your parts simply by laying the cut out pieces on top of each other.**
- **Some parts are marked with an * followed by a R, these means that a copy of this part needs to be made for the Left side by facing the opposite direction. Just turn the template label side down and trace again.**
- **Along with the EVA/craft foam you will need: contact cement, super glue, a rotary tool, rotary sanding bits, scissors, xacto or box cutter, Plastidip or something to seal it with, spray paint, and acrylic paints.**

Hopefully this is helpful and keep in mind it is a free template (so please don't be judgmental). Share this with everyone you know.
