

Simply Cat Pillow

Scale this as large as you like. The Face should be cut from material that will not fray, such as felt or fleece.

The eyes and nose may be embroidered on, painted or sew in place, also cut from non fraying fabric.

Cut 2 pieces of the Body

Cut the Face and attach to the front Body piece.

Add the eyes and nose to the face.

Sew the two Body pieces together, right sides facing each other, leaving an opening at the bottom.

Turn right sides out, stuff and sew the opening closed.

This is a good project for repurposing a sweater or tee shirt and suitable for sewing with a serger.

This may also be sewn by hand.

A second option is to add the Face, then sew the back sides together, leaving plenty of fabric around the edges.

Trim the extra fabric with pinking shears if availble, and leave the edges rough. They will fluff up when washed.
