

**1. NUMBER OF VIEWS**

The student with the most number of views for all of their instructables receives the amount of points equal to the number of students in the class at the time of tallying. The next highest number of views receives the amount of points equal to the number of students in the class at the time of tallying minus one, and so on.

20 students = 20 points  
for most views

More instructables =  
more views

**2. FEATURED INSTRUCTABLE**

Bonus points will be awarded to any student whose instructable is featured by one of the editors at Instructables.

\* a featured instructable often gets posted to the home page which usually results in more views.

10 points

**3. STUDENT RATING**

Your student rating will be determined by your teacher and will be based on the following criteria:

**4. ATTENDANCE**

The student with the fewest number of absences receives the amount of points equal to the number of students in the class at the time of tallying. The next fewest number of absences receives the amount of points equal to the number of students in the class at the time of tallying minus one, and so on.

Absences are totalled regardless of reason.

20 students = 20 points  
for fewest absences

1 Late = 1/2 Absence

**5. PROJECT COMPLETION**

The student with the highest mark receives the amount of points equal to the number of students in the class at the time of tallying. The next highest mark receives the amount of points equal to the number of students in the class at the time of tallying minus one, and so on.

Students must complete all project requirements in order to be eligible for prizes. Projects submitted later than any posted due date may be assessed a late penalty of up to 5 points.
